The developers considered that the complainer had an unrealistic expectation of a nil impact resulting from the development. This "unrealistic" expectation would not have come about had the complainers been disabused of any such notion at the consultation stage.								
		Noise complaints are received mainly during spells of high wind when each property is down wind of the turbines.								
		The noise complained about affects the property at all times but obviously the noise is perceived as more of a problem during the night.
